## **Webster Groves Residents Vote in Favor of Prop. W**

(Webster Groves, Mo.) - According to unofficial results, Webster Groves residents voted in favor of Proposition W in the April 5<sup>th</sup> 2022 election with 64.7 percent of the vote. Proposition W had asked "Shall there be a Charter Review Advisory Board to make Recommendations to the City Council to revise and amend the Charter?"

"As the newly seated Council and Mayor begin meeting this spring, advertising for and selecting the members of the Charter Review Advisory Board will be one of their first priorities," said Dr. Marie Peoples, City Manager of Webster Groves.

The City's Charter was adopted on May 23, 1954. Along with the Municipal Code of Ordinances, the Charter is essentially the rules of the City of Webster Groves. It outlines the form of government (Council-Manager Government) and the roles of the elected officials, lengths of their terms and pay. All the details of governance for the City of Webster Groves are included in the Charter.

In January, the Council agreed to place Prop. W on the April ballot. In 2020, residents of Webster Groves voted in favor of being asked by ballot for a Charter Review Advisory Board at least every eight years, in conjunction with a mayoral election.
